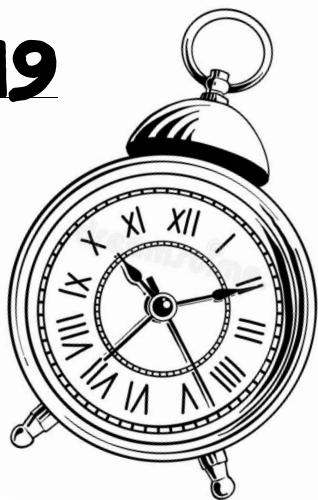


2020 COVID-19 PANDEMIC COMMUNITY TIME CAPSULE

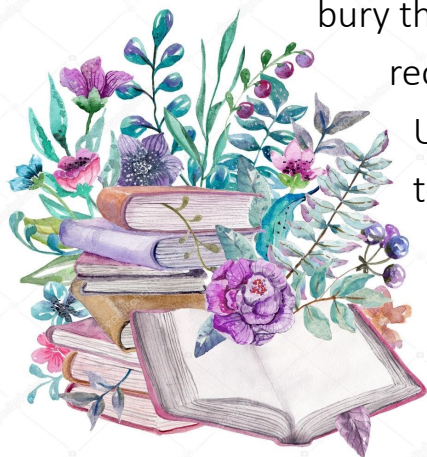
